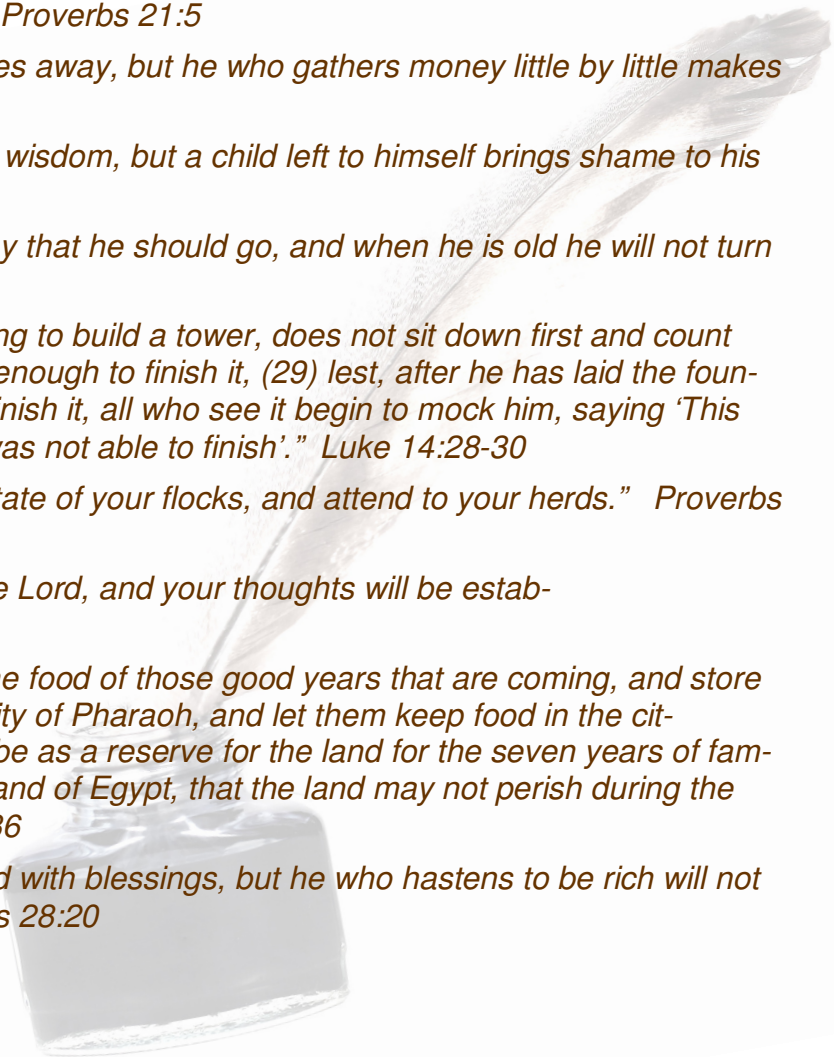


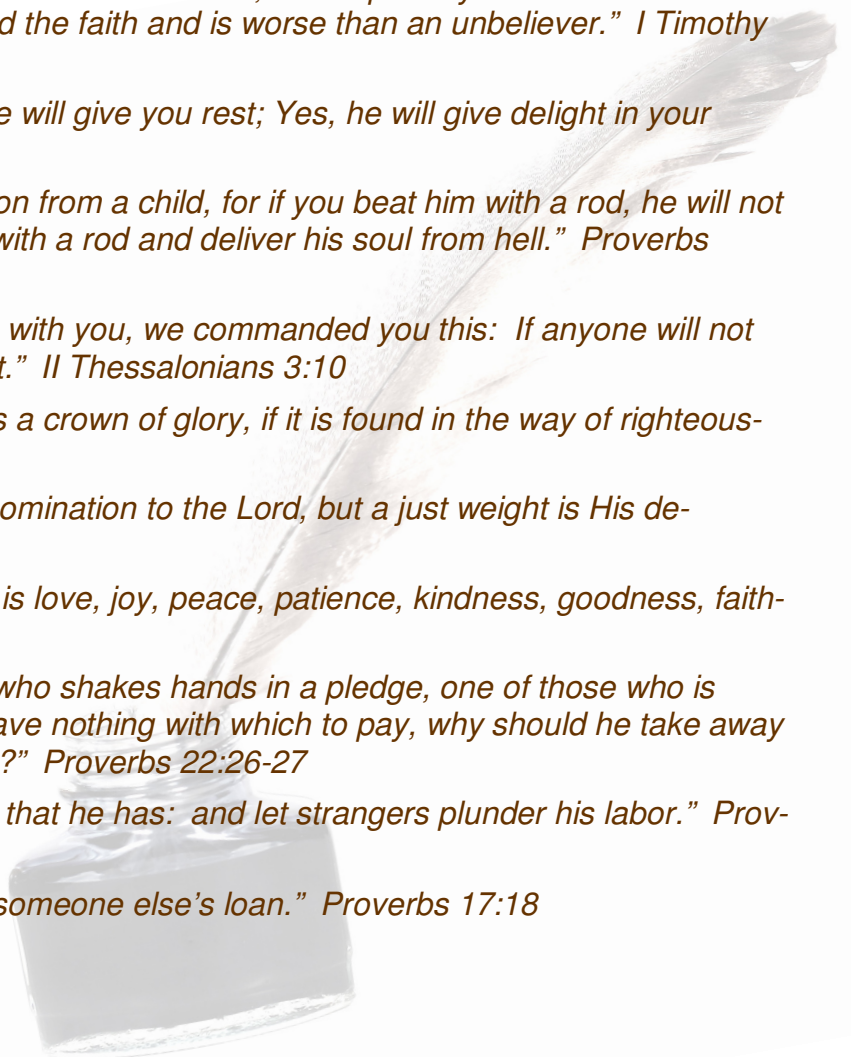



Money Scriptures

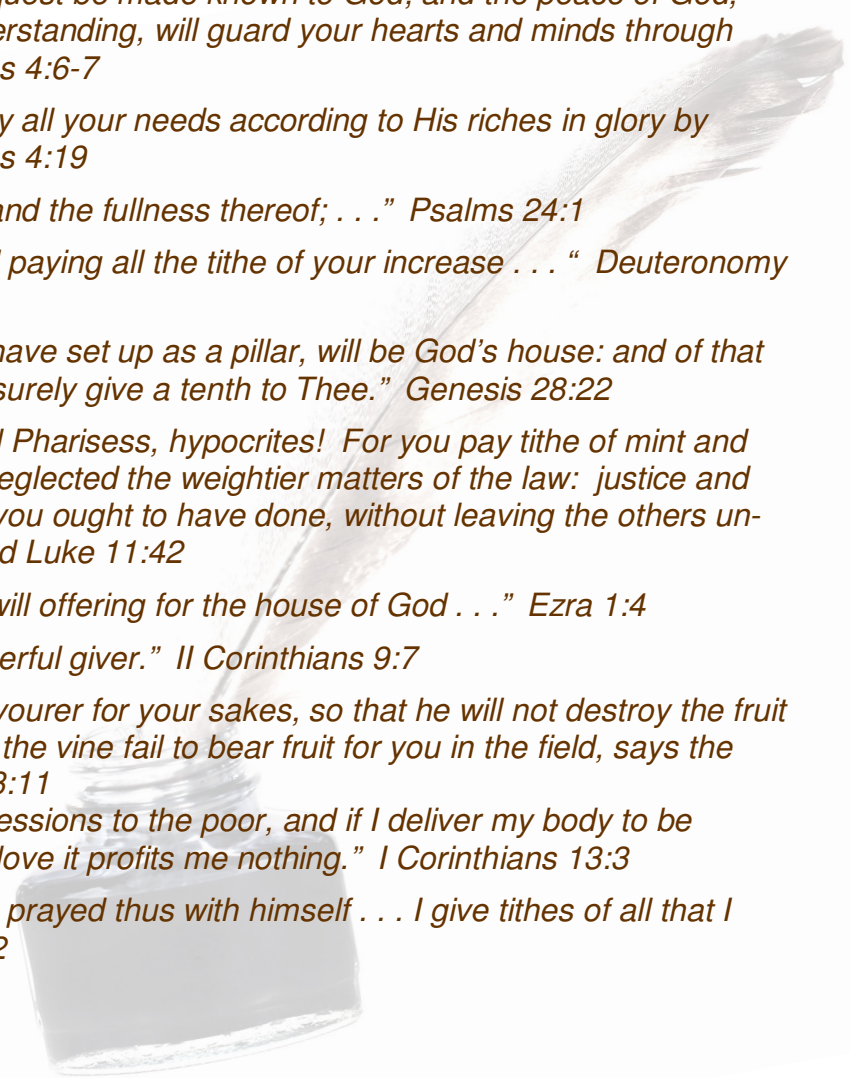


- *“He who is surety for a stranger will suffer for it, but one who hates being surety is secure.” Proverbs 11:15*
